1. **DEADLINE** for scholarship applications is **0900 hours on April 6, 2026**.
NO EXCEPTIONS. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.

3. Refer to the application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., recommendation letters, high school diploma or GED, etc.). Incomplete applications will not be considered.

NOTE: The **Fresno Fire Chief's Foundation** will handle all deposits of funds to Fresno City College for selected program(s) or will reimburse the scholarship winner.

Purpose: To provide a single year scholarship for up to TWO (2) deserving Fresno County underserved/minority status youth interested in or intending to pursue a fire service-related course of; Emergency Medical Technician (EMT-1) certification program (Fresno City College or similar) and/or the Fresno City College Fire Academy.

Underserved/Minority Status Means: Any population segment with exceptional service needs including, but not limited to, the following: socioeconomically disadvantaged, educationally disadvantaged, geographically isolated, people who are racial or ethnic minorities, women, and/or first-generation students.

Award Components: Up to THREE (3) scholarships may be awarded depending on the funds generated for distribution each year as selected by the **Fresno Fire Chief's Foundation Scholarship Committee**.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
2. Applicants must be between the ages of 18-21.
3. Applicants must meet the Underserved/Minority status criteria listed above.
4. Applicants must have a valid driver's license.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Complete and submit the application form electronically.
2. TWO (2) letters of recommendation from choice of high school teacher/mentor, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's character, achievements, and/or involvement in the community.
3. A copy of your high school diploma or GED certificate.
4. Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the question on the enclosed essay sheet.
5. Oral Interview with the **Fresno Fire Chief's Foundation Scholarship Committee** member(s) if you are selected as a finalist.
